

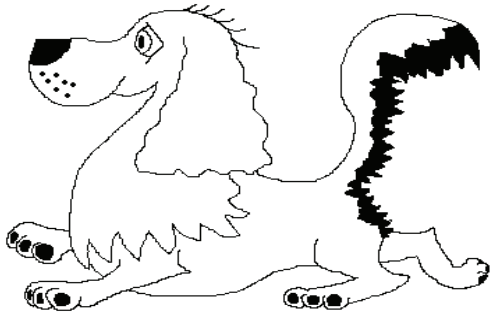

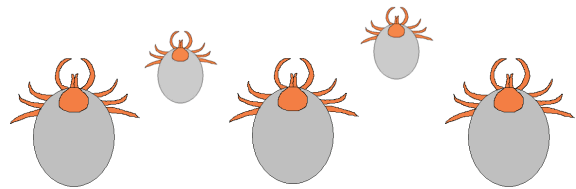

### TICK ALERT

Every year this time we tend to harp on about the same things but believe us it's for good reason.....Paralysis ticks are going to be in plague proportions this year. We've had quite a mild winter. Cold weather and frosts kill ticks. Large numbers will have survived from last year. The weather is now warming up which makes ticks more active. The rain we've had in the last couple of weeks will probably start them off on a feeding frenzy. **SO BEWARE**



Prevention is far better than cure so make sure you have your animals on a good tick prevention regime—Frontline spot-on or Spray , Advantix spot-on (Dogs Only) , Proban tablets or Liquid , Tick collars or even tick rinses.
